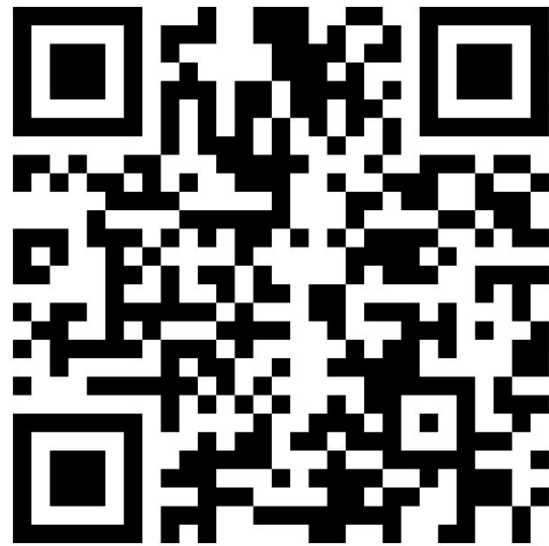



 - Students living within Santa Cruz City School District can request an Intradistrict transfer to attend a different school (Ex: SCHS to HHS, HHS to SHS, etc.)
 - Check your school of residence now → 
- **Students new to district or with lapse in district enrollment but live within district boundaries:**
 - Follow steps on website for “Families New to SCCS” (https://sccs.net/parents__students/enrolling)
- **If student address is outside SCCS District boundaries:**
 - An approved Interdistrict Transfer Application is required to enroll. Apply with your home district first.
 - Current applications will hear from SCCS with approval status

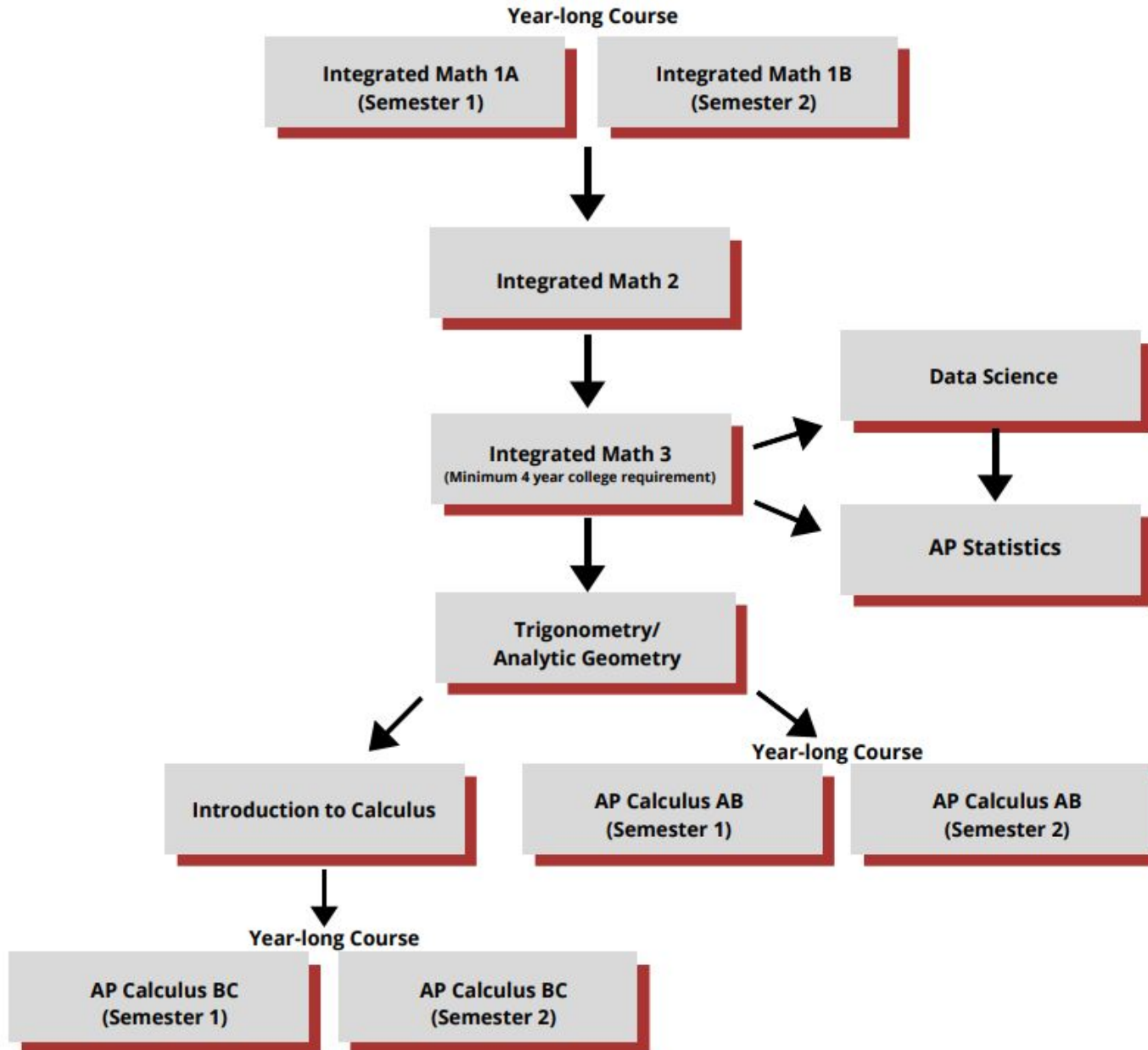
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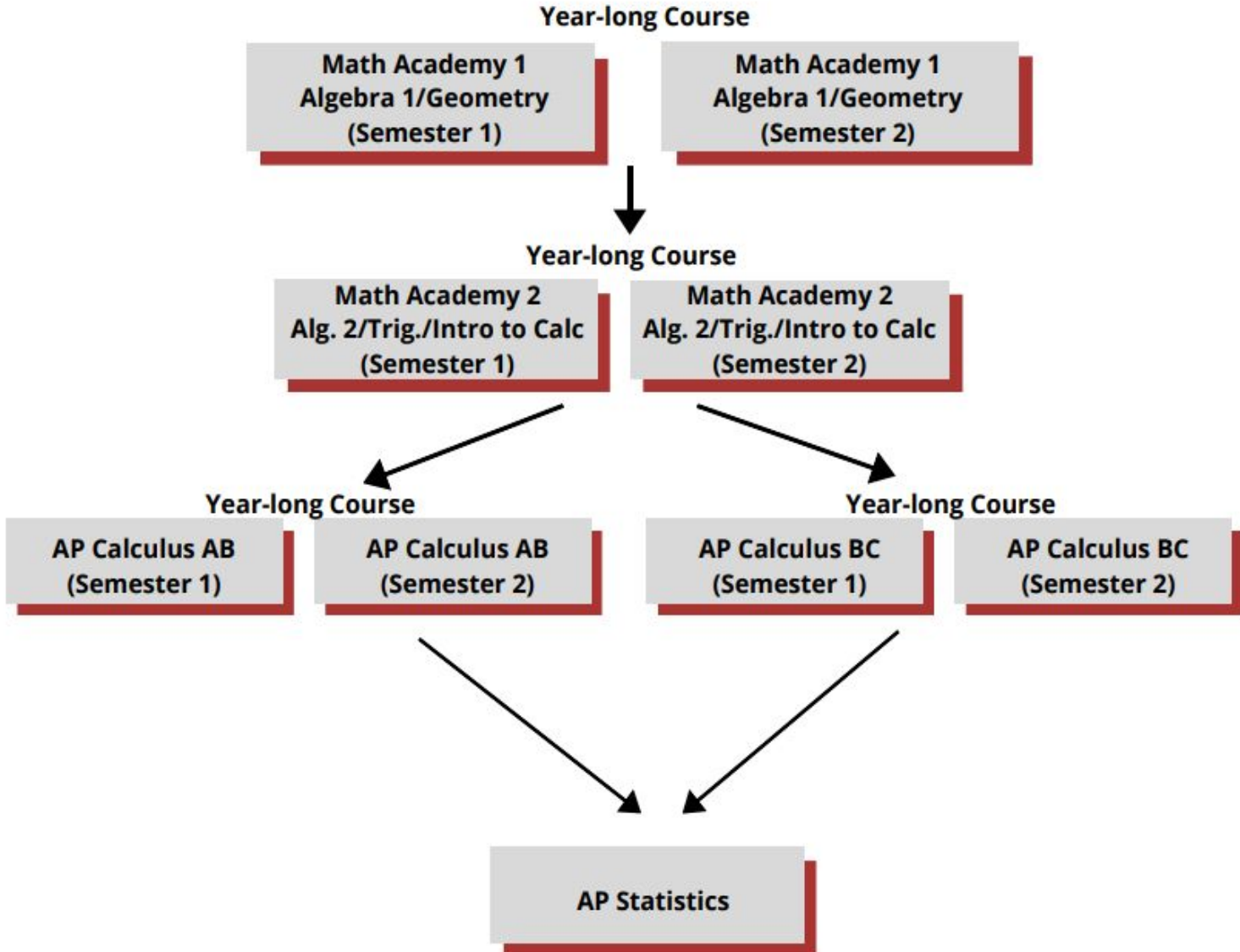

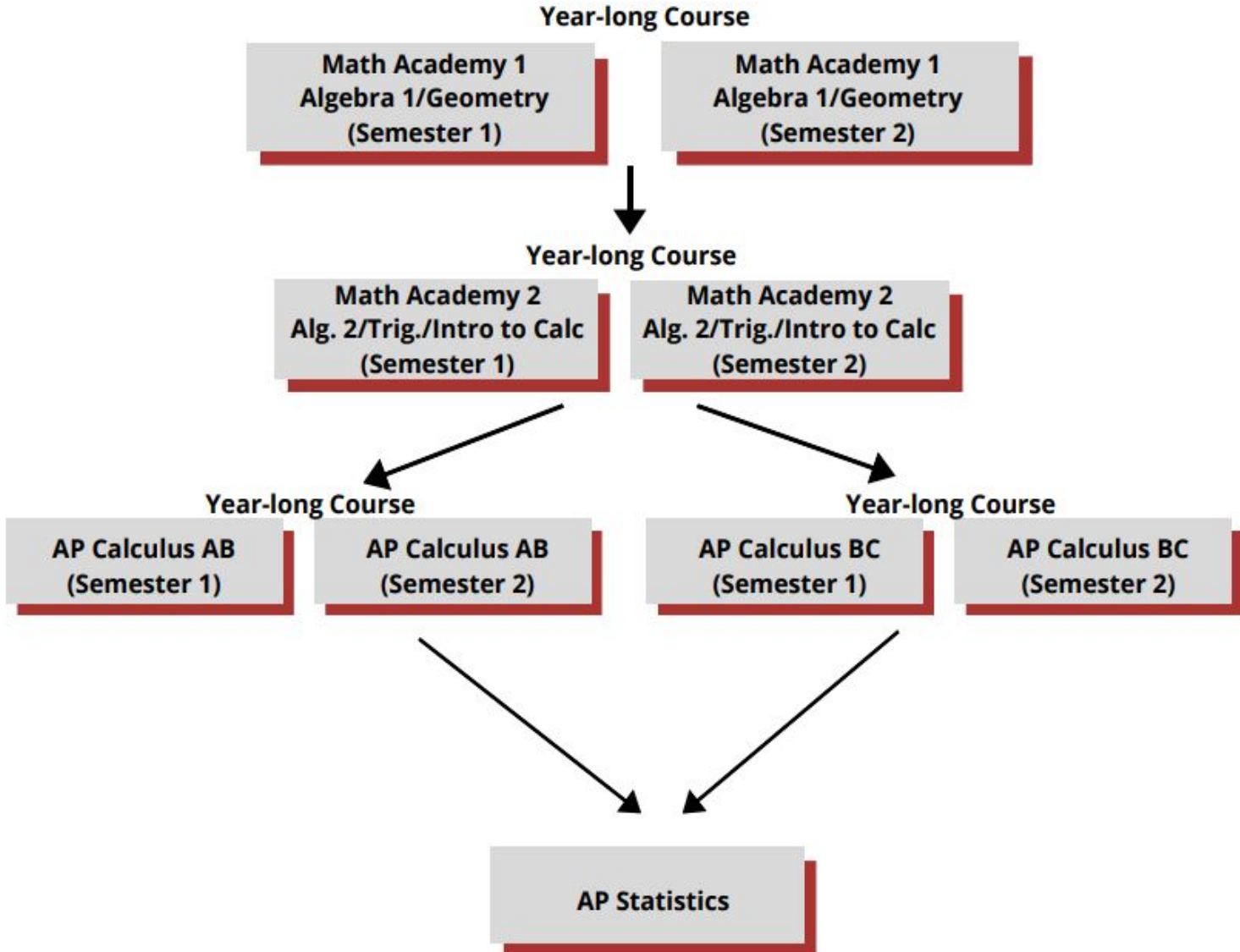
